

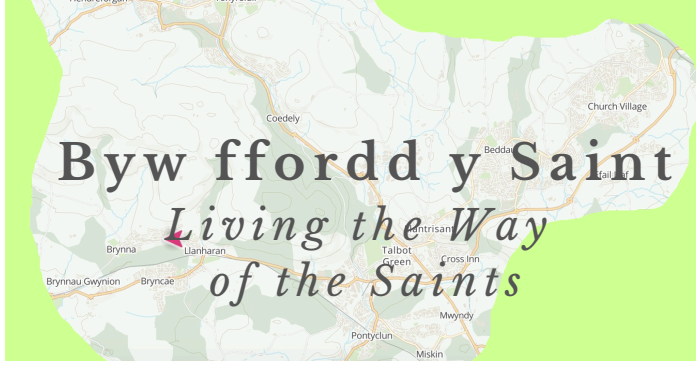
Psalm 66: 8-20
